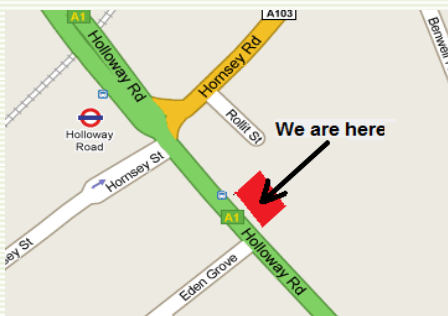
Speakers:
