

The MD Route Interview

The interview for BSc Biomedical Sciences leading to MD is designed to assess the following:

- Your understanding of medical training and the role and duties of a doctor
- Your motivation, commitment and ability with regards to training as a doctor
- Your understanding of ethical dilemmas that doctors may come across in their practice
- Relevant experience (paid or voluntary) that you have with regards to training as a doctor
- Your knowledge about this particular course, which is quite complex and your ability to fund the course

It is recommended that you look at websites such as NHS careers, the British Medical Council and the General Medical Council.

More informally, but with some very good advice from the medical student perspective (excellent on interviews and interview preparation) is the website www.wanttobeadoctor.co.uk

The interviews will last around 40 minutes and applicants are expected to be prompt and punctual.

In the case where interviewees have outstanding academic qualifications to take in order to meet the academic criteria for the course, then a conditional offer would be made for a place on the course if the interview is successful.
