Career History

Emir is currently Associate Managing Editor of The Sunday Times, responsible for the editorial finances of Britain's leading Sunday broadsheet newspaper. Married with a young son, he lives in Battersea.

He then joined the Royal Artillery in which he served for three years. Emir, 53, has spent most of his working life in catering and logistics both here and in the international market. In 1995, he changed careers by attending night school and completed his CIMA exams. He subsequently joined The Sunday Times as an editorial accountant.

He has held a number of trustee positions in the charitable sector and was recently appointed to the main board for the selection committee of the Queen's Award for Voluntary Services. He is a Liveryman of the Worshipful Company of Wheelwrights, where he is raising funds to support a team of disabled ex-servicemen for the 2012 Paralympics in London.
