### Times

### Module Levels and Prerequisites

There are three teaching levels, Certificate, Intermediate and Honours, which broadly correspond to the first, second and third year of study.

Please note: some Intermediate and Honours level modules may only be taken if the student has already completed lower level modules on a related topic – these modules are known as prerequisites.

**When a prerequisite is listed you should make sure that you have studied a corresponding course at your home campus** and therefore will have enough subject knowledge to approach the new material.

### Module codes

The module code consists of 3 parts: The department initials, the number code, and the **N** or **C** to indicate whether the module is being taught at **North** campus or **City** campus. For example: MK\*1001\*N

Where the module is highlighted in **purple** on this list and has no campus designation e.g. **AC1002 Accounting**, the module is being taught separately at **both** campuses and you can choose at which campus you would prefer to take your module – **either** North **or** City (**not both!**). When filling in your Intended Programme of Study form, you must indicate where you want to take your chosen module. The choice could depend on which best fits your schedule, or which campus you prefer.
