What is the programme?

The Refugee Healthcare Professionals Programme can support you with a range of activities including:

- information, advice and guidance
- IELTS and advanced language
- support with your professional requalification including PLAB, ORE, Overseas Nurses Programme etc
- workshops and courses to help develop your skills and career prospects
- help to explore alternative routes to employment in healthcare
- work placements in healthcare
- job search support.

Who is it for?

This programme is for refugee healthcare professionals, living in London, unemployed or employed, with refugee status (or ILR, HP, DL, including spouses of refugees) or asylum seekers with permission to work.

Refugee healthcare professionals include doctors, dentists, nurses, midwives, pharmacists, allied health professionals or healthcare scientists.
