Philosopher Alasdair MacIntyre to speak at inaugural Aristotelian conference

On Friday 3 June the inaugural conference of the Contemporary Aristotelian Studies specialist group of the UK Political Studies Association will be hosted by London Metropolitan University's Faculty of Law, Governance and International Relations.

Twenty five papers will be presented by speakers from across Europe and North America.

The opening paper will be by Professor Alasdair MacIntyre, Senior Research Fellow at London Met's Centre for Contemporary Aristotelian Studies in Ethics and Politics (CASEP).

The best papers from the conference will be published under the editorship of conference organiser Kim Redgrave and fellow CASEP member Mustafa Ongun.

The conference itself will see the launch of *Virtue and Politics: Alasdair MacIntyre's Revolutionary Aristotelianism* (University of Notre Dame Press, 2011), edited by Paul Blackledge and CASEP Director Kelvin Knight.
