Arrival and check in

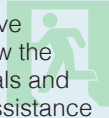
When you arrive at the open day please check in or register at the welcome desk.

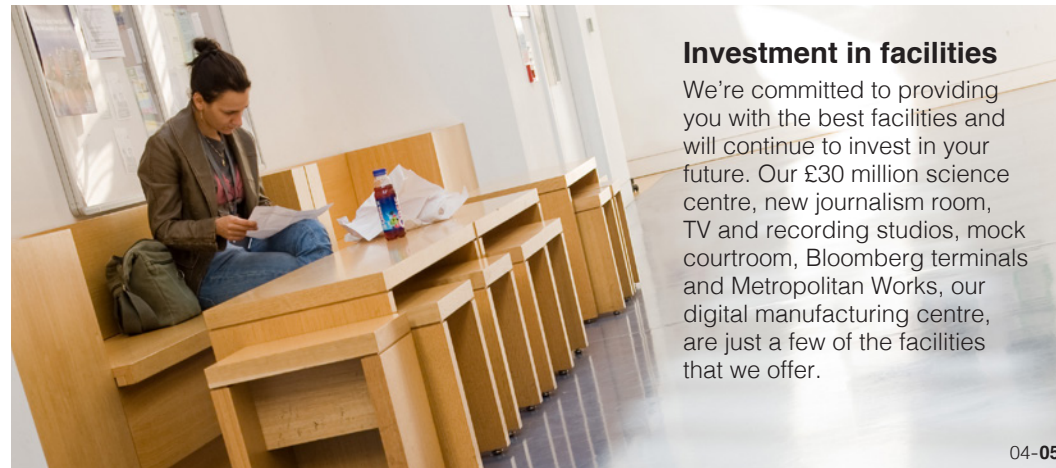
