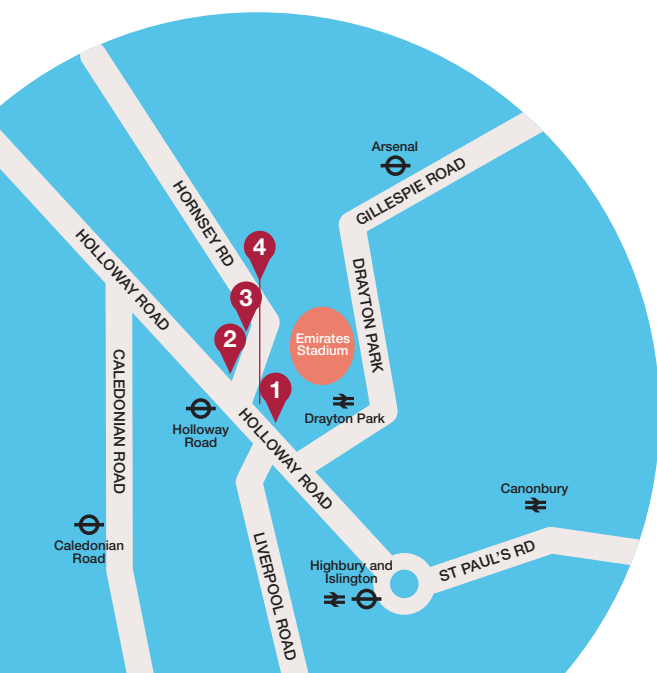
Holloway campus
